I. Role Dawgs

- II. Student Representative Sanaa' Gadson spoke on behalf of the Beach High Role Dawgs.
 - 1. The Role Dawgs are a program that is in place at Beach High School for Positive Behavior intervention supports and will work in conjunction with PBIS.
 - 2. A role dawg is someone who will take leadership and ownership over their own actions as well as set the goals for their fellow classmates to do the right thing.
 - 3. They help others stay and get out of trouble.
 - 4. The role dawgs currently consist of students in the 9th grade academy with upperclassmen serving as mentors.
 - 5. They had to interview, get teacher recommendations, and be in good academic standing to be considered for the Role Dawg team.
 - 6. Role Dawgs are students who stop fights, intervene during arguments, tutor other students, help others with their grades and set the expectation and standard for what a Beach Bulldog represents.
- 1. Police will mentor Role Dawgs and give them someone to go to
- 2. Role Dawgs will have teacher mentors to go to when they have a problem or issue

Starting Point

- A. Student selection
- B. Interventions

1. Students will have a network of people to work with
2. Talk to police, have a conversation and build a rapport
3. Nothing formal, as to not portray that these are “bad kids”
4. Act normal – this is not something they HAVE to do, make it seem like this is normal
5. Behavior doesn’t necessarily get challenged, however, behavior is discussed to identify antecedents and why the behavior occurs
6. Proactive approach to reduce incidents and antecedents to stop behavior

C. Goal

1. Fight a cultural wall
2. Have the students let their guard down

D. Parents –

1. Contact parents
2. Get approval from parents/guardians
3. Face to face interaction
4. Formal letter introducing program to parents and students.
5. Parent interview to get an idea of life at home
