School Council Members Present: Kelli Hamilton, Traci Schumacher, Mike Cerotti, Kelly Bringman, and Lynne Ballard

Members Not in Attendance: Ann Chamberlain and Maya Clark-parent representative

MINUTES:

Traci Schumacher- School Council President, called the meeting to order at 8:12 am. Committee members signed in and were introduced. Committee members were provided with a meeting agenda. The committee welcomed Mr. Lower, our board representative. Mrs. Hamilton reviewed meeting dates for the remainder of the year.

Mrs. Hamilton shared current celebrations at Georgetown. Mrs. Anita Simmons, who has been teaching at Georgetown since the school opened, was honored as the Exchange Club's teacher of the month this week. Mrs. Hamilton is pleased to announce that our middle school has applied for a grant to pursue STEM certification. The first \$5,000 will be used to educate teachers and prepare them for a STEM curriculum. After this initial year of training, the school will receive an additional \$5,000 for use in implementing the curriculum with students and competing in state and national STEM competitions.

Mrs. Hamilton presented the SRI and MAP test results from the fall. Additionally, the council reviewed data from the spring of 2012 through the current test scores. Overall, test scores have increased, as the goal scores have increased each year. From fall 2015 to spring 2016, test scores increased greatly overall.

Mr. Lower shared ESPLOST III information and encouraged the council to vote for and promote the initiative. Normally the ESPLOST funds only facilities, but this time will provide some busses so hopefully will be able to have only one bus route, rather than staggering school start times so that busses can run two routes. Mr. Cerotti asked if there is a possibility that Georgetown will receive additional athletic facilities. Mr. Lower reported that there simply is not space for athletic facilities. When Georgetown converted to K-8, consideration was not really made for athletic facilities. However, the new planned K-8 schools near New Hampstead and Groves will be able to share facilities with those nearby high schools.

Mr. Lower discussed the Opportunity School District amendment and encouraged the council to vote no on this amendment.

Council voted to change the meeting time to 9:00 to accommodate the schedules of parents and business-partners.

No further business to discuss. Motion for adjournment.

Meeting adjourned at 9:07 am.
