SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS:	<p><u>CCRPI</u></p> <p>Dr. Kristy Fleming is our new REP math teachers. She has held various roles from principal to coach to teacher and is now retired. She has much experience with CCRPI and “unpeeling the onion” on data, so she presented a review of the data that we recently received.</p> <p>She discussed the 8 standards of mathematical practice which carry through to every grade level. Teachers must emphasize these to improve students’ approach to mathematics; hopefully we can improve on this as we continue.</p> <p>Dr. Fleming recommends that staff look at the progress score, which indicates how students are growing academically from one year to the next, and work to boost the students who are not showing growth.</p> <p>K Bringman brought up the concern about losing so many students to specialty programs from 5th to 6th grades. K Hamilton noted that we are now offering advanced math, ELA, and Spanish to hopefully retain some of those students. Additionally, Georgetown is piloting Eureka math at the middle school level, so once that is implemented district-wide, we will be ahead of the other schools.</p>
