



The April 13, 2017 School Council Meeting for Haven Elementary School was called to order at 4:10 pm in the Media Center by Rev. Ray Singleton, Council Chair.

Members in attendance were: Parent Representatives: Rev. Ray Singleton and Ms. Leslie Stevens Teacher Representative: Ms. Tanika Johnson, Business Partner: Ms. Stephanie Johnson – SunTrust Bank, and Principal: Ms. Dionne Young.

Meeting materials were disbursed as members arrived.

Rev. Singleton opened the meeting with a welcome that was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and review of the agenda.

The council's secretary, Stephanie Johnson shared the following quote from Kid President with those in attendance.

- "Be somebody who makes everybody feel like a somebody."

The minutes, which were sent prior to the meeting via email, were reviewed and approved as written.

The meeting was then turned over to Mrs. Young for the Principal's Report.

Principal's Report

A copy of Haven's Chevron Report for the first and second quarters was disbursed to attendees. The Chevron Report is compiled for the Chief Academic Officer to monitor the performance of the Impact Schools in our district.

- Mrs. Young explained that Haven had also been identified as a Focus School and an Opportunity School by the Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) since it had not met the required performance benchmarks.
- Haven's goals on the Chevron Report were to :
 - Improve student growth and achievement as measured by the annual College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) Score by 35 by the end of school year (SY) 2016 -17.
 - Increase the percentage of students PROFICIENT in math as measured by the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment in grades 2 – 5 by the end of SY 2016-17.
 - Increase the percentage of students reading at determined Lexile levels for grades 3 and 5 by the end of SY 2016-17.
- Mrs. Young shared:
 - **Chevron Rept. - Key Performance Indicators Section**
 - The percentage of 2nd – 5th grade students passing assessments in each subject area declined between first quarter (Q1) and second quarter (Q2) with the exception of 3rd grade Social Studies that remained flat and 5th grade Social Studies that increased by 5%.
 - **Chevron Rept. - Georgia Milestones Assessment System (GMAS) Section**
 - Students scoring at or above proficiency increased in all academic areas between SY 2014-15 and SY 2015-16 with the exception of ELA.
 - **Chevron Rept. - CCRPI Section**
 - The components of the CCRPI and how it impacts the Chevron Report.
 - Haven has seen overall improvement, but has yet to make it to the goal of 60 points.
 - The various ways Haven could gain achievement points based on testing and innovative practices in academic and disciplinary areas.
 - Some potential points the school will earn this academic year based on its' participation in a GDOE Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program.
 - **Chevron Rept.** - The Funding, Additional Data, School/Program Strategies and Principal's Corner sections were generally addressed.
 - Mrs. Young mentioned that the most current testing results should be available in approximately two weeks and student retesting will occur during the last week of school.

- **Information about House Bill 338**
 - Very similar to Amendment 1, the referendum that voters rejected in November 2016.
 - There are 12 schools in Chatham County that will be impacted if the bill should pass
 - Attached articles were not shared during the meeting, but have been provided as additional resource materials.

- **Construction Update**
 - The school is approximately 80% complete.
 - Crews are working on the interior (painting & floor installation).
 - Hoping school will be 100% complete by the end of May so Certificate of Occupancy can be issued in June.
 - A date for a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony has not been determined.
 - The new school will hold approximately 650 students

Ms. Young shared Haven's upcoming events.
