The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm by Mrs. Heather Handy, Principal. Members in attendance can be found on the sign-in sheet. The meeting began with members standing to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mrs. Handy gave a report on the following:

- AdvancED Accreditation Visit will be next week, February 28 and March 1, at Jenkins. The faculty and staff worked on this process since the beginning of school, dividing into standards and collecting evidence of what is done at Jenkins. The visiting team received the report and evidence on January 28, 2017.
- A meeting was held two weeks ago with two local engineers to review the process the District uses when building a new school for ESPLOST 3. Jenkins is slated to be the first project of ESPLOST 3, an engineering firm will be selected in April/May of 2017. Mr. Wohlfeil added additional information on the process and stated the contract between the District and Parsons has been extended into ESPLOST 3. The major questions still unanswered are (1) Where will Jenkins be built and (2) Will Jenkins face DeRenne Avenue.
- A review of sports was given. Spring sports (baseball, soccer, track & field, tennis, golf) have begun. The girls' basketball team advanced to the first round of the playoffs, ending third in the region. That is the best finish for the girls' team since 2012. The boys' basketball team has advanced to the second round of the playoffs, and will play at 6:00 on Thursday, February 23, 2017 at home. If the boys team advances, there may be a coin toss to decide what team will host the third round. The state championship game will be held at Georgia Tech.
- GMAS testing will begin April 24, and run for eight days. AP testing will be the first two weeks of May. Students scheduled in classes with a SGM will take their post-SLO in April and May.
- A test preparation course was added to the master schedule this week to help increase SAT and ACT scores for our students. This class will be discussed in the upcoming preregistration process later in March.

- Competitive Teams
- Jenkins was allowed to send two students to the District Science Fair earlier in February. One student placed third in her category, and another placed first, winning \$600. Both students are progressing to State Science Fair.

- Registration Process
- Two diploma seals have been added in the areas of Fine Arts and Foreign Language (International Skills). Students that take advanced courses in these areas and complete a capstone project may be eligible for the additional seal to be added to their diploma.
