PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Lockdown Protocols. There are 3 levels of lockdown protocol dependent on situation: first is to lock all exterior doors, second is to contain students to certain areas of school, and third is to hide in classrooms. These are all being discussed and practiced with students so that they are prepared in case of emergency. 2. An Active shooter drill will be taking place in February. Letters explaining what is going to happen will go home to parents end of January. 3. New CCRPI Scores – 2014 score was 85.6, 2015 was 77.8 and 2016 was 81.9. Ms. Phillips explained that these numbers are hard to evaluate since the standards keep changing from year to year. The key is the Achievement Gap which is the gap between the lowest and the highest performers. The goal is for this gap to be as low as possible. 4. Enrollment Updated – currently at 903, down from 912 as of the last meeting. 5. School Accountability Goals – still in test windows 6. Specialty School Program has been renamed to Choice Program. Marshpoint currently has 40+ students with the choice program classification in addition to the regular lottery students.
