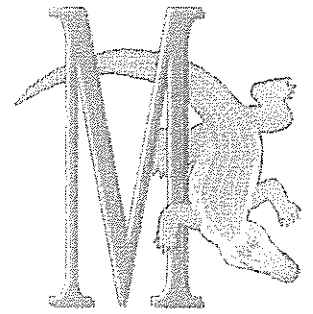

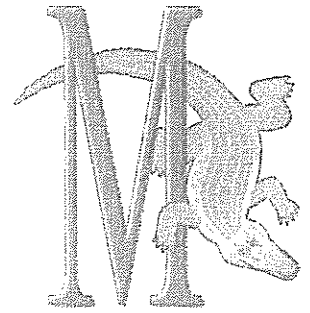

Horny - affiliations (track funds etc.)

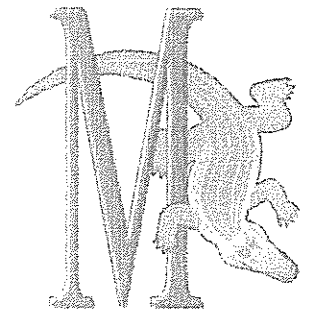

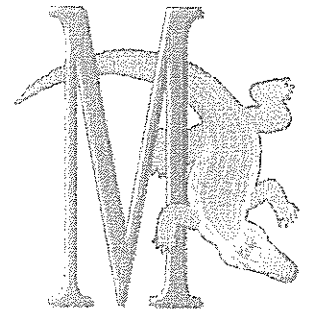
