APPROVAL OF MINUTES:	Minutes approved unanimously
OLD BUSINESS:	Mr. Daughtry reviewed the painting of the building.
PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:	<p>A large number of students are participating in credit recovery for Q2 and Q3 – over 120 students. We did offer this earlier in the year, but now students are feeling the urgency. We are hosting it from 3-5pm. We are offering bus passes for those that need transportation.</p> <p>We are moving into SRI and MAP as well as EOCT for the 9th grade classes.</p> <p>Before we leave today, please feel free to walk the building. The new colors make it look brighter and cleaner. In this room (Drama) we are taking up the carpet to add tile and add a projector. We want a new feel when students come in the fall. The parking lot will be repainted before the fall. We are trying to change the culture of the building and wanting to get the message out to the community.</p> <p>This is the last year for Ms. Howard and Ms. Tucker on the council. We will hold elections in the fall for new teachers. We did lose Ms. Singeisen and the replacement has also resigned from JA. We are looking for a new business member at this point as we do not know the leaders in JA any longer. If you have recommendations for a community person, please let</p>

	<p>me know.</p> <p>We have not received test data back, so we are waiting on those numbers. We are also waiting on the retest roster for 8th grade. It does not mean they will necessarily be retained, but they need remediation and an opportunity to retest.</p> <p>Mr. Daughtry announced Ms. Connelly's resignation for next year and thanked her for the work she has done.</p> <p>Mr. Daughtry also discussed how we are looking at adding a Genius Hour and having each faculty member sponsoring a club. He has gotten information on how Coastal is doing this and will be sharing with the School Leadership Team to gain involvement from faculty.</p>		
OTHER REPORTS:	Mr. Daughtry asked the President, Ms. Robinson, if there were any topics she would like addressed.		
NEW BUSINESS:	<p>Ms. Gilford provided a report on our progress of surveys. We are at 100% participation including students at alternative sites related to SWMS. This will earn us points on CCRPI.</p> <p>We are working with transition of students transitioning to SWMS and out of SWMS. Some elementary schools have come here, we have gone to some schools and we are participating in an elementary fair at Shuman. We will be going to WFHS in early May.</p> <p>We are almost finalized in our 8th grade activities including the Bridging ceremony. Some dates had to be changed due to testing, but information is coming out this week. We are adding a dance under the moonlight on a river boat cruise this year.</p> <p>Mr. Daughtry also announced that we have another group through the city who will be mentoring 50-70 of our young men in addition to the 100 Black Men. We will also have a representative from Girls on the Run presenting a proposal to partner at SWMS.</p>
