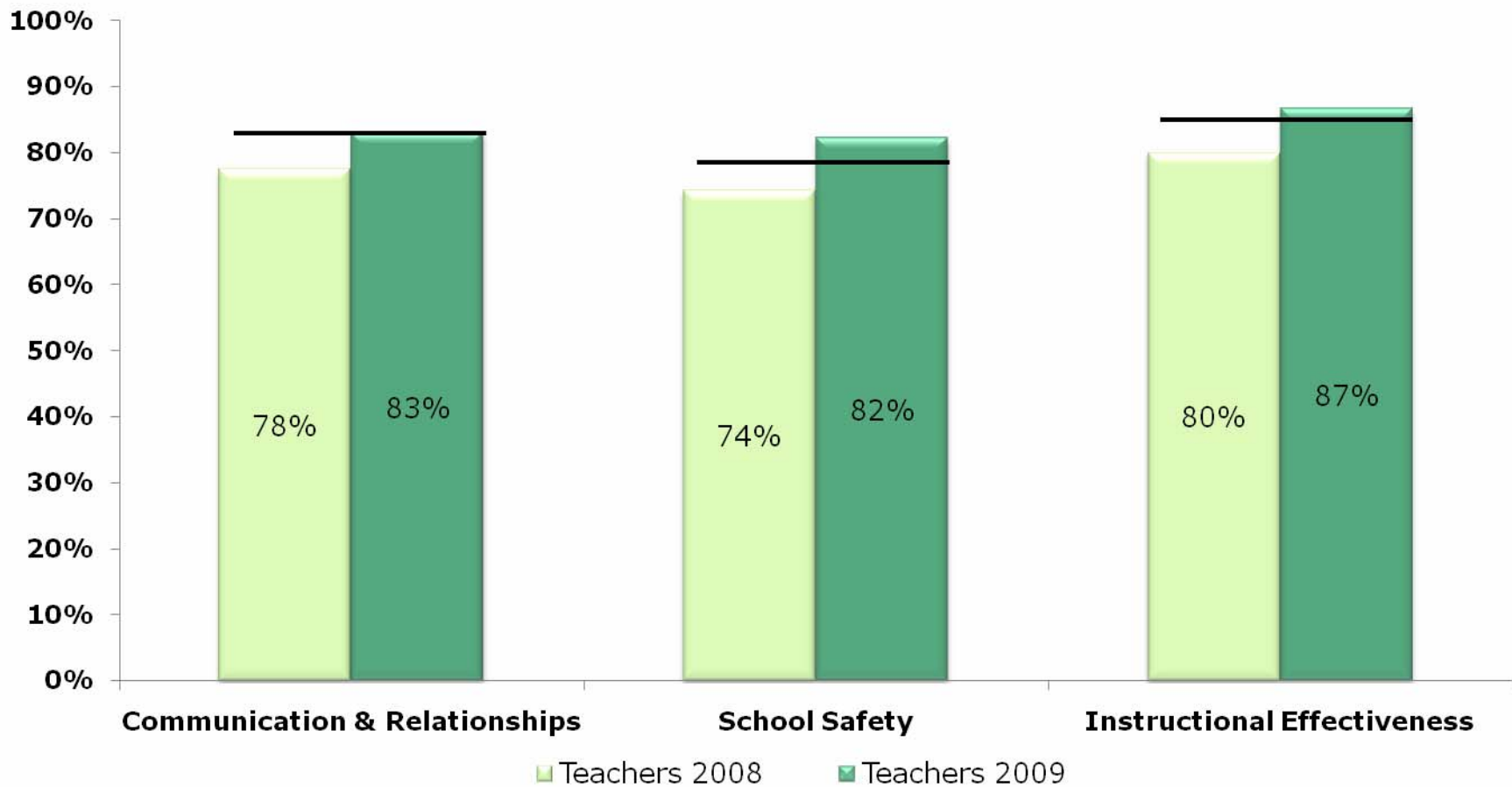

Percentage of Teachers Reporting Positive Perceptions of Their School

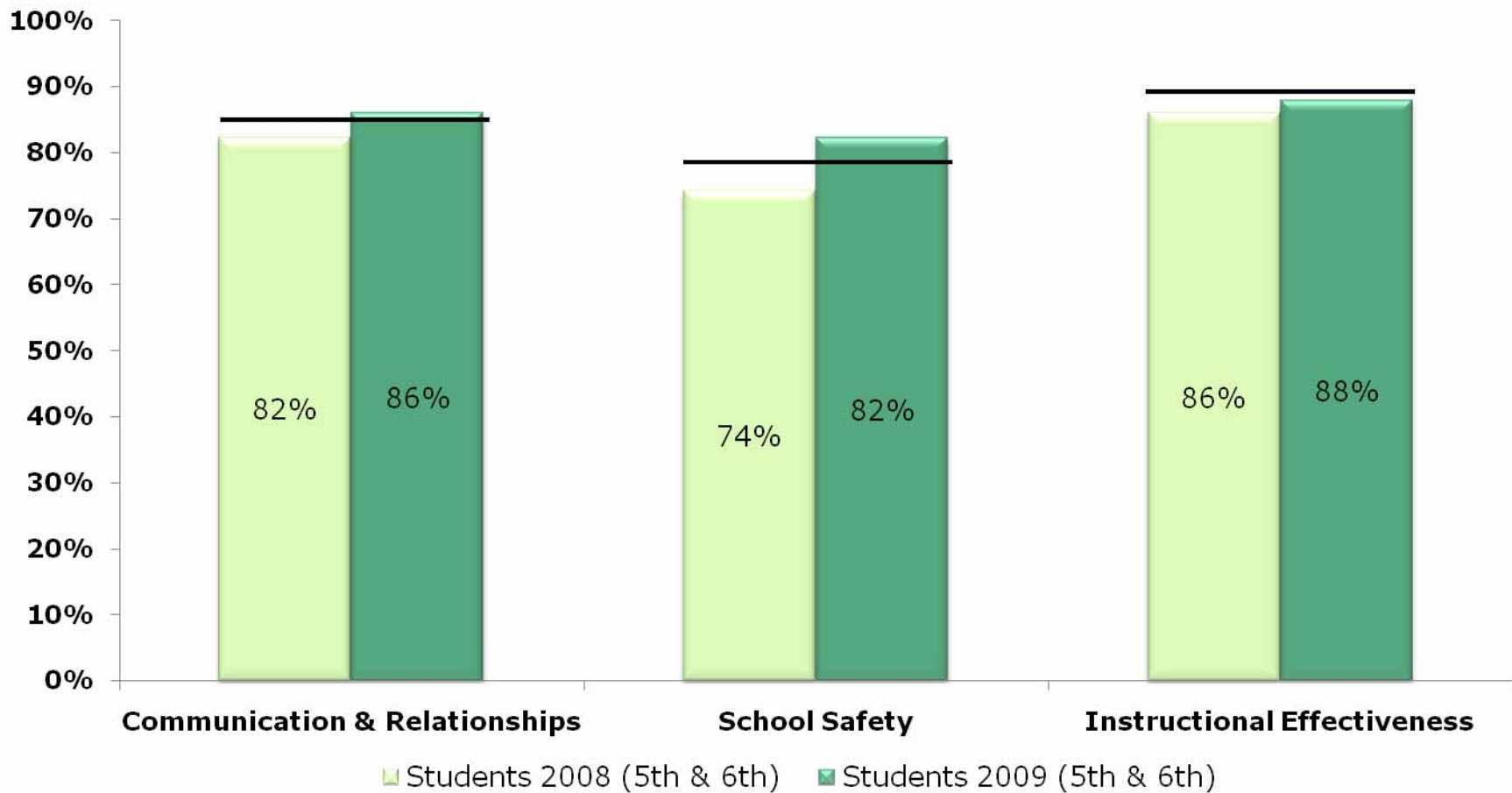

Percentage of Students Reporting Positive Perceptions of Their School

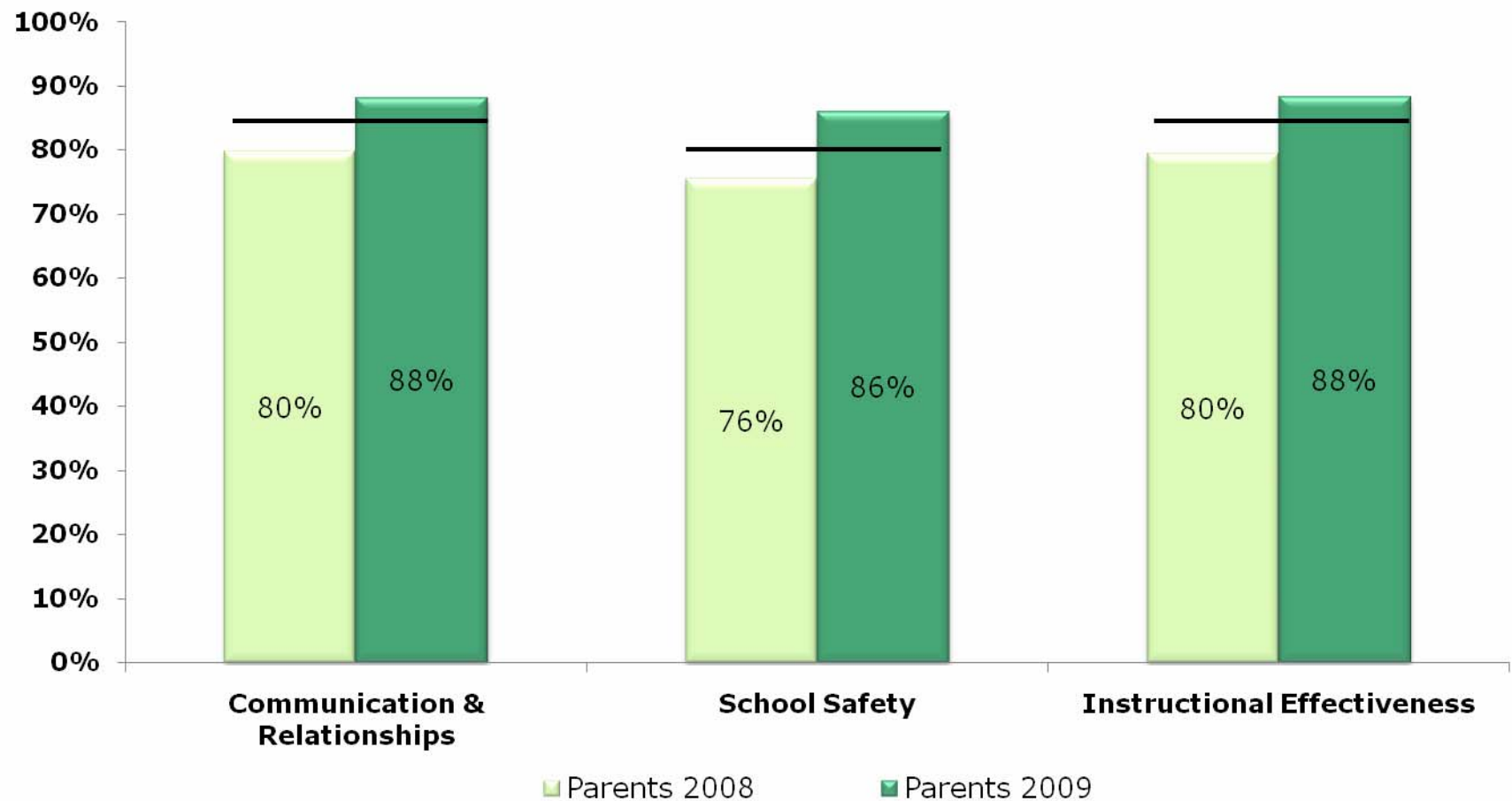
