Objective, Baseline & Target

Objective: To increase the percentage of students who are reading on grade level by the end of grade 2 as measured by the Lexile scores students receive as a result of taking the Reading portion of the CRCT and receiving a reading scale score.

Baseline: SY 2008-2009: 62% of 2nd graders met the target objective.

Target: By 2012, 77% of students will be reading on grade level by the conclusion of their second grade academic year.



What Are Lexiles?

- A Lexile is a standard unit for measuring the comprehensibility of text.
 - Measures Semantic (meaning)
 - Syntax (sentence structure)
- Lexile scores are reported on the CRCT reading test.
- Scores are reported as a Lexile measure from 0L to 2000L.
- A 330 Lexile represents the score desired at the end of 2nd grade.



End of 2nd Grade Students Reading Level- District





End of 2nd Grade Students Reading Level by Gender






