
Objective D: Weapons and Drugs

Fourth Quarter Report: 2010-2011 School Year

Executive Summary

In accordance with Strategic Objective 3D, the district is to reduce the number of Weapons and Drugs on school campuses as measured by official police reports to 45 or less for each category by FY 2012. For FY 2011 through June 30 there have been 69 incidents involving drug violations and 59 incidents involving weapons violations. With a continued emphasis on Strategic Objective 3D, we are ensuring that a minimum of 3 Random Administrative Inspections are done per school every week. We have experienced a slight increase in incidents involving weapons and drug related incidents in FY11 vs. FY10. Continued emphasis is being placed on communicating the repercussions of bringing weapons and drugs on school campuses to students and families and we are continuing to monitor compliance for the Random Administrative Inspections.

Weapons and Drugs Comparison through June 30



Attached is a breakdown of drug and weapons violations by elementary, middle, high and alternative schools for FY11 for through June 30, 2011.

Drug violations are viewed under four areas of the official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

- OCGA 16-13-30 Purchase, possession, manufacture, distribution, or sale of controlled substances or marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (a) Purchase, possess, or have under control any controlled substance.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (j) Possession, have under control, manufacture, deliver, distribute, dispense, administer, purchase, sell, or possess with intent to distribute marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-32.4 Manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled substances in, on, or near public or private schools

Weapons are viewed under the following official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

OCGA 16-11-127.1 Carrying weapons within school safety zones, at school functions, or on school property.
