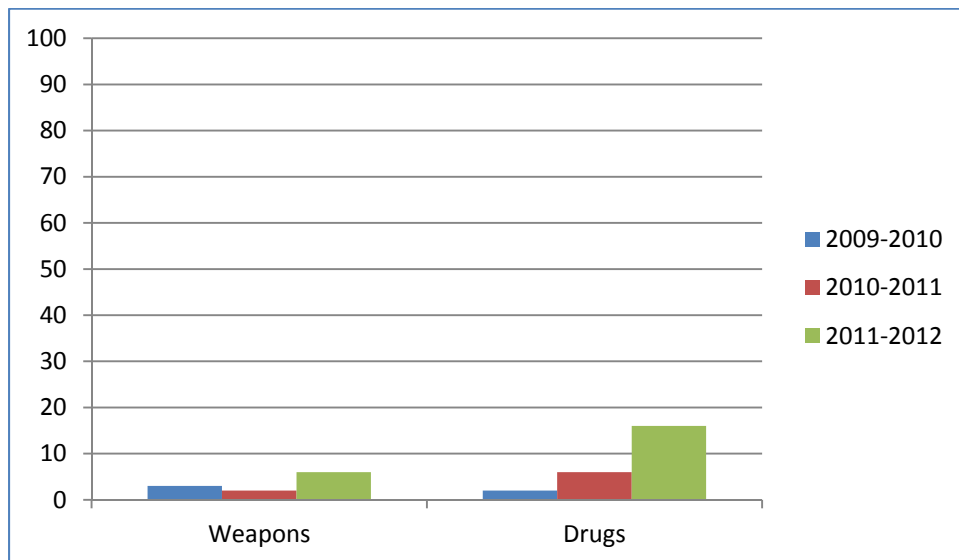
### Objective D: Weapons and Drugs

#### First Quarter Report: 2011-2012 School Year

##### Executive Summary

In accordance with Strategic Objective 3D, the district is to reduce the number of Weapons and Drugs on school campuses as measured by official police reports to 45 or less in each category by FY 2012. For the period of July 1, 2011 thru September 30, 2011 there have been 16 incidents involving drug violations and 6 incidents involving weapons violations. With an emphasis on Strategic Objective 3D, we are ensuring that a minimum of 3 Random Administrative Inspections are done per school every week. Staff has also emphasized to students and parents/families the consequences of bringing weapons onto school property, especially at the elementary level. There has been an increase in drugs and weapons as compared to the first quarter of FY2011. The majority of weapons incidents are occurred at the middle school level while the majority of drug incidents occurred at the high school level. The Campus Police department has been directed to take a more aggressive stance regarding weapons and drugs on campus by conducting multiple sweeps at schools where we are seeing increases in these incidents. The Operations division will also share this report with the Academic Services division to ensure that the emphasis on these items is being relayed to schools.

##### Weapons and Drugs Comparison



Attached is a breakdown of drug and weapons violations by elementary, middle, high and alternative schools for FY12 for the period of July 1 thru September 30, 2011.

Drug violations are viewed under four areas of the official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

- OCGA 16-13-30 Purchase, possession, manufacture, distribution, or sale of controlled substances or marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (a) Purchase, possess, or have under control any controlled substance.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (j) Possession, have under control, manufacture, deliver, distribute, dispense, administer, purchase, sell, or possess with intent to distribute marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-32.4 Manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled substances in, on, or near public or private schools

Weapons are viewed under the following official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

OCGA 16-11-127.1 Carrying weapons within school safety zones, at school functions, or on school property.
