Objective, Baseline & Target

Objective: To increase the percentage of students who are reading on grade level by the end of grade 2, 4, and 7 as measured by a Lexile reading scale score of 330L, 630L, and 880L respectively.

Baseline: SY 2010: 63% of 2nd graders, 75% of 4th graders, and 66% of 7th graders met the target objective.

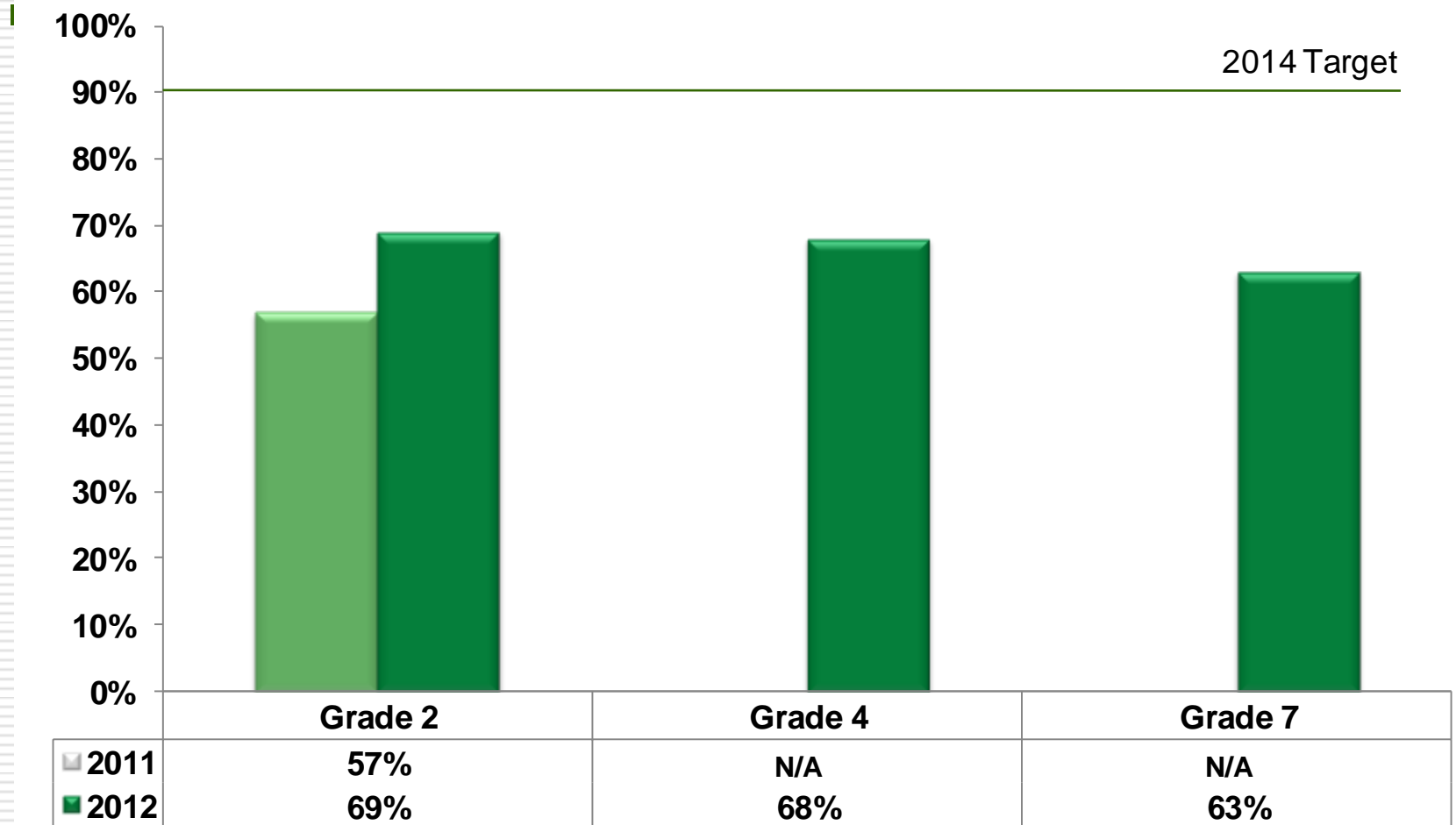
Target: By SY 2014, 90% of students in grades 2, 4, and 7 will be reading on grade level by the conclusion of the academic year.



Background Information

- A Lexile is a standard unit for measuring text complexity.
- Readers' scores are reported as a Lexile measure from 0L to 2000L.
- Lexile scores for 2nd grade students are reported on the Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) for SY2011 and SY2012.
- Lexile scores for 4th and 7th grade students are reported on SRI for SY2012.

Second grade SRI data collected for 2011 and 2012. SRI assessment license expanded in 2012 to include grades 4 and 7.

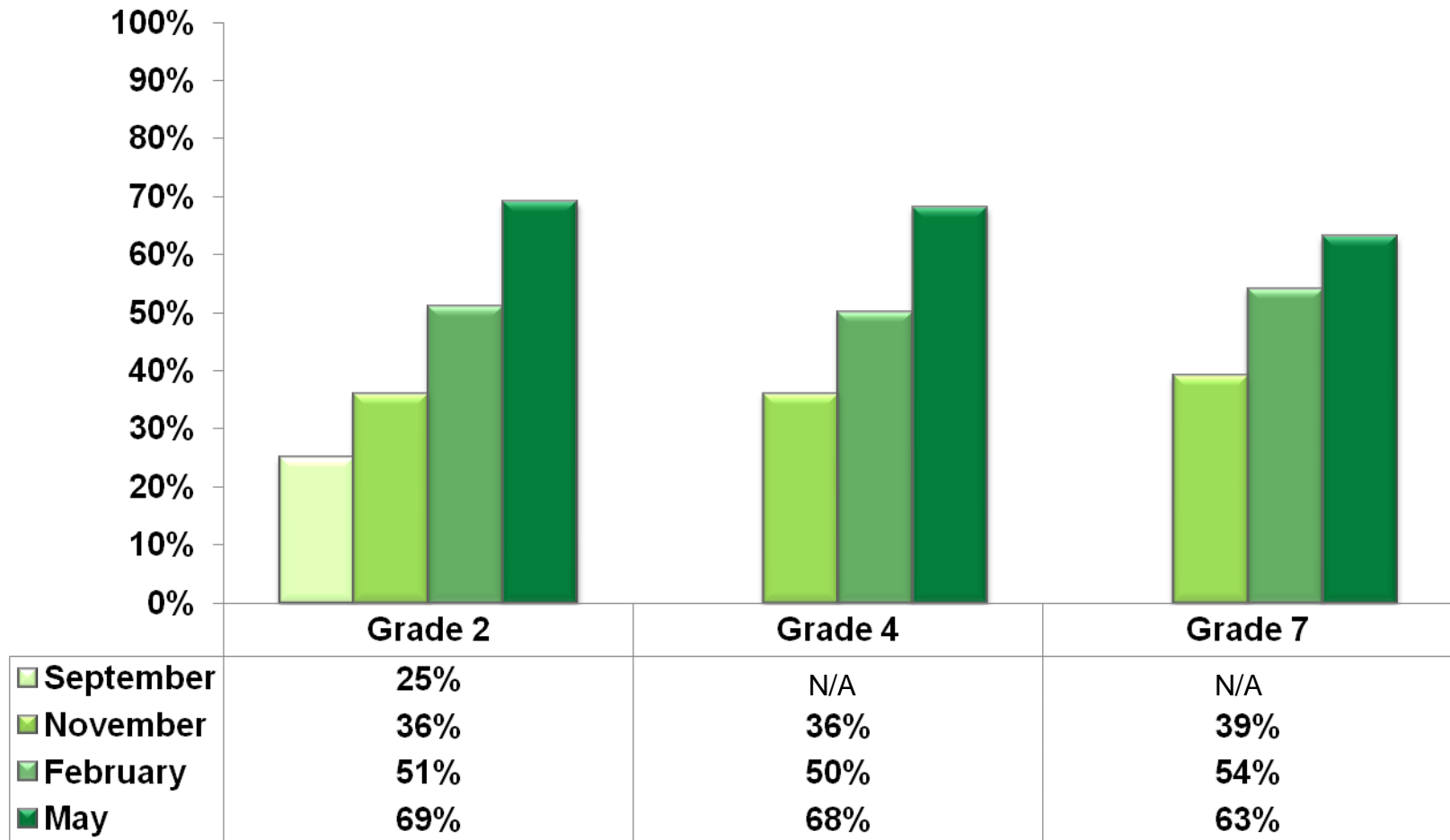

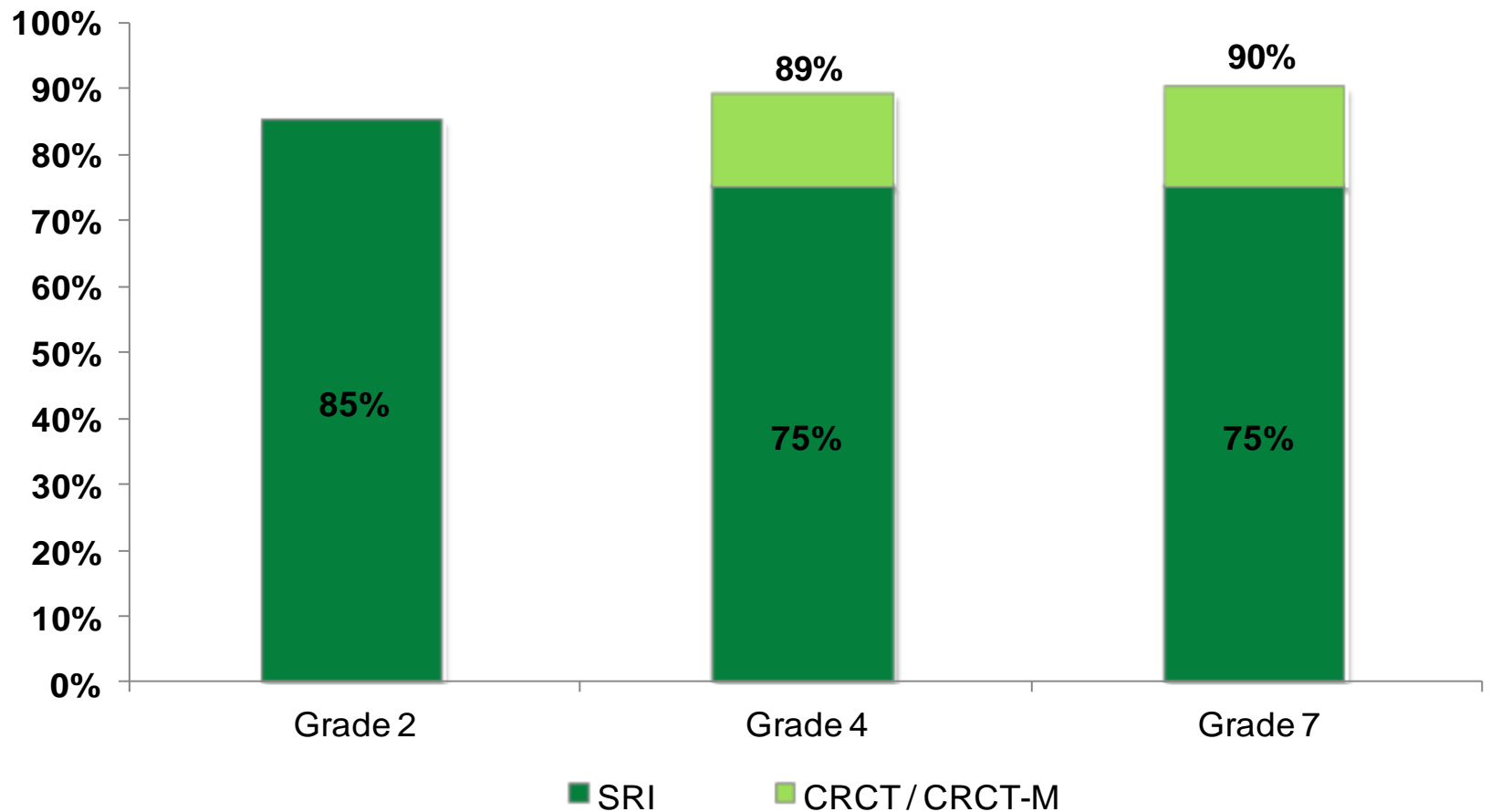

Students Meeting 2012 Gateway Promotion Requirements



Gateway promotion Lexile criteria are as follows:

2nd grade = 180L; 4th grade = 580L; 7th grade = 815L

4th & 7th graders may meet criteria via SRI or CRCT / CRCT-M



Actions

- During the 2012-2013 school year, professional learning literacy coaches and instructional technology coaches will assist teachers as they develop model literacy blocks of instruction.
- During the 2012-2013 school year, elementary principals will supervise the implementation of kindergarten and 1st grade literacy based on *DIBELS Next* results to modify instruction based on student needs.
- During the 2012-2013 school year, middle school principals will conduct walkthroughs to ensure the implementation of SRA Reading Mastery.



Story Behind the Numbers

In May of 2011, 2nd grade student established baseline data for ROGL using the Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI). Baseline data for 4th and 7th grade students using the SRI was established in November of 2011.

The Scholastic Reading Inventory is administered online. It provides a more accurate Lexile measure than the previous converted CRCT score. The SRI requires an extensive use of vocabulary and inference skills.

- Data from the Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) was collected from the administration dates below. The highest Lexile achieved over the range of administration dates was used for this report.

- Students tested: Grade 2=2,892, Grade 4=2,815, Grade 7=2,323.
- Reading on grade level is defined as Lexile scores at or above 330L at the end of second grade, 630L at the end of fourth grade, and 880L at the end of seventh grade.
