Executive Summary
Spring 2013

About the CRCT

The Georgia CRCT is designed to measure student achievement relative to the content of the Common Core Georgia Performance Standards (CCGPS). In 2013 students in grades 3 – 8 participated in reading, English/language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies subject area tests.

A CRCT score of 800 or above indicates performance that meets the state standard and a score of 850 or above exceeds the standard. Passing scores are those that either meet or exceed the state standard. Third-grade students are required to pass the reading portion of the CRCT in order to be promoted to the fourth grade, while students in the fifth and eighth grades must pass both reading and math in order to advance to the next grade. Students who do not pass these areas on the first attempt have a second opportunity to test.

This executive summary is a follow-up to the board presentation on Reading on Grade Level. District Accountability System Goal 1, Objective B seeks to increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standard in the core content areas as measured by the CRCT, and has established the following performance targets for grades 3, 5, and 8:

Highlights from the spring 2013 administration of the CRCT include the following:

Reading

- The percentage of students meeting/exceeding standard in reading reached 90% or above in all grade levels, with a high of 97% in grade eight. Eighth grade students surpassed the district's 2014 performance target for reading.
- Compared to last year, SCCPSS improved student performance in reading in grades three, five, six, and eight, with the third, fifth, and eighth grade gains reaching the level of statistical significance.

- Bartow, Butler, Gadsden, Garden City, Low, Shuman Thunderbolt, White Bluff, East Broad, Ellis, and Mercer each achieved double-digit gains compared to last year. J.G. Smith, West Chatham, East Broad, Ellis, Garrison, Godley Station, and Georgetown achieved a 100% pass rate in one or more grade levels.

English/Language Arts (ELA)

- The percentage of students meeting/exceeding standard in ELA ranged between 86% in grade three, to 94% in grade five. Fifth and eighth grade students met the district's 2014 performance target for ELA.
- SCCPSS achieved increases over 2012 ELA pass rates in grades five and six, although the gains reached the level of statistical significance in sixth grade only.
- Across all grade levels, White Bluff earned the greatest one-year increase in ELA pass rates, including a 12 point gain in grade five. Howard, J.G. Smith, Ellis, Garrison, and Georgetown each achieved a 100% pass rate in one or more grade levels.

Mathematics

- The percentage of students meeting/exceeding standard in math ranged from 69% in grade three, to 85% in grade five.
- SCCPSS students in grades four, five, six, and eight achieved gains over the prior year, with eighth graders accomplishing a 12 point increase in their math pass rate. All gains in the area of math were statistically significant.
- Twenty-two schools achieved double-digit gains in math pass rates from 2012 to 2013. Schools with the highest increases within elementary grade levels include Bloomingdale, Haven, and East Broad, while Bartlett, Coastal, Hubert, and Myers achieved the greatest gains in middle grade levels. Heard, Howard, J.G. Smith, and Garrison achieved a 100% pass rate in one or more grade levels.

Social Studies

- Social studies pass rates ranged from 63% in grade six, to 78% in grade three. Students in fifth grade surpassed the district's 2014 performance target for social studies.
- Social studies pass rates improved over last year at all grade levels, with all gains except those in seventh grade reaching the level of statistical significance.
- Nineteen schools achieved double-digit gains in social studies pass rates compared to the prior year. Butler, Low, White Bluff, and Isle of Hope had the greatest increases within elementary grade levels, while East Broad and DeRenne achieved the greatest gains in middle grade levels. J.G. Smith and Garrison achieved a 100% pass rate in at least one grade level.

Science

- The percentage of students meeting/exceeding standard in science ranged from 58% in grades six and eight, to 74% in grade seven. Eighth grade students met the district's 2014 performance target for science.
- SCCPSS students in grades three, four, five, six, and eight made gains over last year. Sixth grade students achieved the greatest gain, with a 5-point increase that attained the level of statistical significance.
- Among elementary grades, White Bluff achieved the greatest one-year gains in science, while East Broad and Hubert earned the highest gains in middle grades. J.G. Smith attained a 100% pass rate in 5th grade, and Garrison reached a 100% pass rate in seventh grade.

Overall

- SCCPSS performance is strongest in the areas of reading and English/language arts; however, students in most grade levels are making significant gains in math, social studies, and science.
- SCCPSS pass rates are exceeded those of the state-assigned group of demographically similar districts* at all grade levels in the areas of reading, ELA, and math, as well as in the elementary grade levels in social studies and science.
- For the first time since implementation of the GPS/CCGPS curricula, SCCPSS has reached state level pass rates in multiple grade levels. This includes third, fifth, and eighth grade in the area of reading, along with fifth grade ELA.
- Retest opportunities in third, fifth, and eighth grade reading, and fifth and eighth grade mathematics increased pass rates in those areas by 1 to 8 percentage points, resulting in final reading pass rates that ranged from 95% - 98%, and math pass rates that ranged from 82% - 90%.

*This group includes Atlanta City Schools, along with Clarke, Clayton, DeKalb, Dougherty, Liberty, Muscogee, Richmond, Spalding, and Troupe counties.

Actions

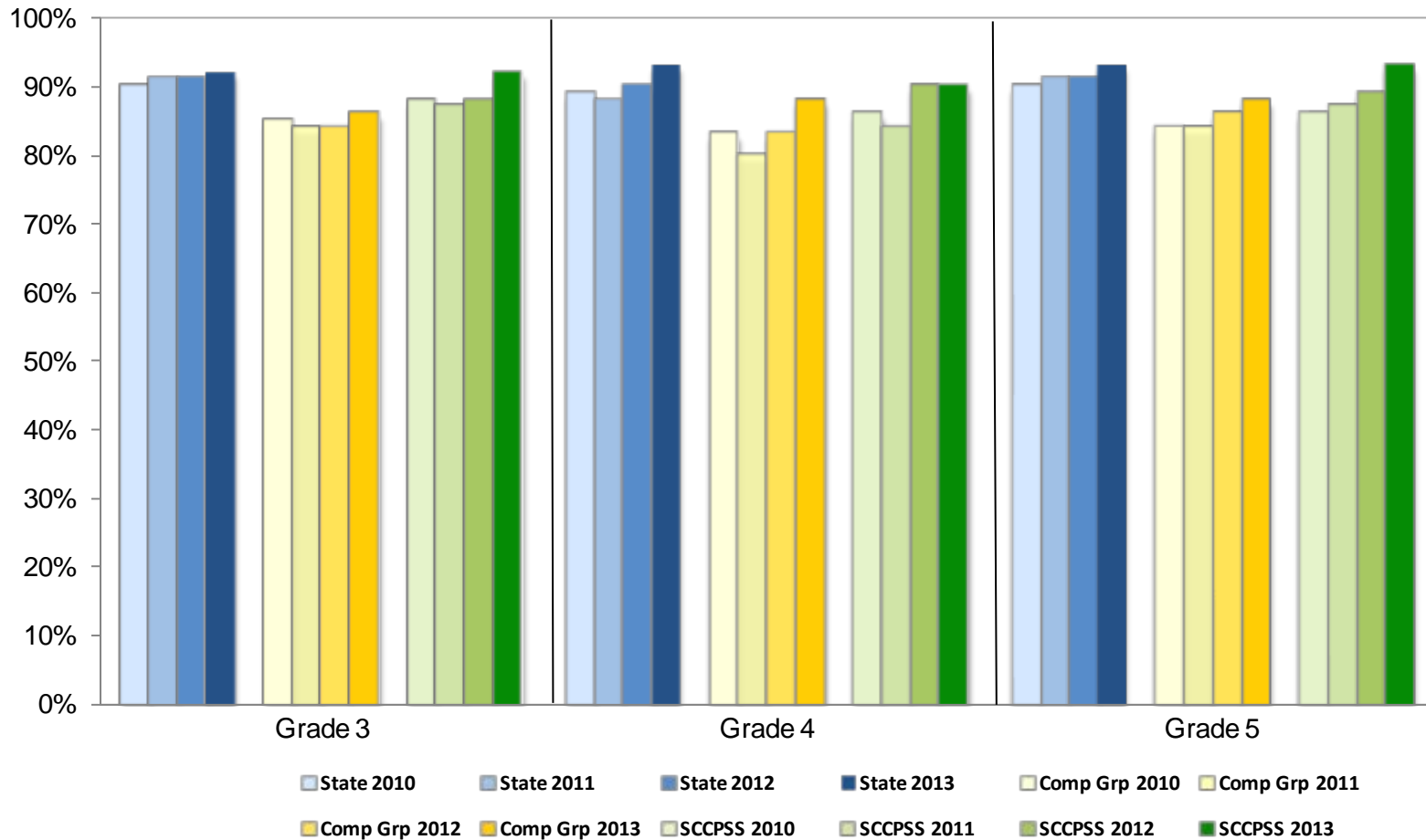
During the 2013-2014 school year, SCCPSS will take the following actions to ensure that students meet or exceed state standards on all areas of the CRCT:

- Elementary and middle school principals will continue to monitor implementation of the reading intervention tools (revised literacy plan, SRA Reading Mastery, and SRI) through the following: school improvement plan; formal and informal classroom observations of the teachers; implementation of required literacy block; and review and feedback of teacher lesson plans.
- Elementary, middle, and K-8 school principals will ensure students are allowed appropriate time (60 minutes recommended) each week to work on Compass Learning Odyssey math activities. Principals will review math activity usage reports during data team meetings and discuss outcomes to ensure fidelity of implementation.
- Elementary, middle, and K-8 school principals will ensure teachers are progress monitoring and holding conferences with students to discuss progress towards math goals.
- Curriculum and Instruction, in collaboration with the school principals, will extend the training of teachers in Literacy Design Collaborative and Document Based Questioning. These initiatives will strengthen the literacy connections in the classroom for science and social studies.
- Elementary, K-8 and middle school principals will observe social studies and science teachers to ensure use of primary source documents and/or hands-on instruction as an integral part of the instruction.

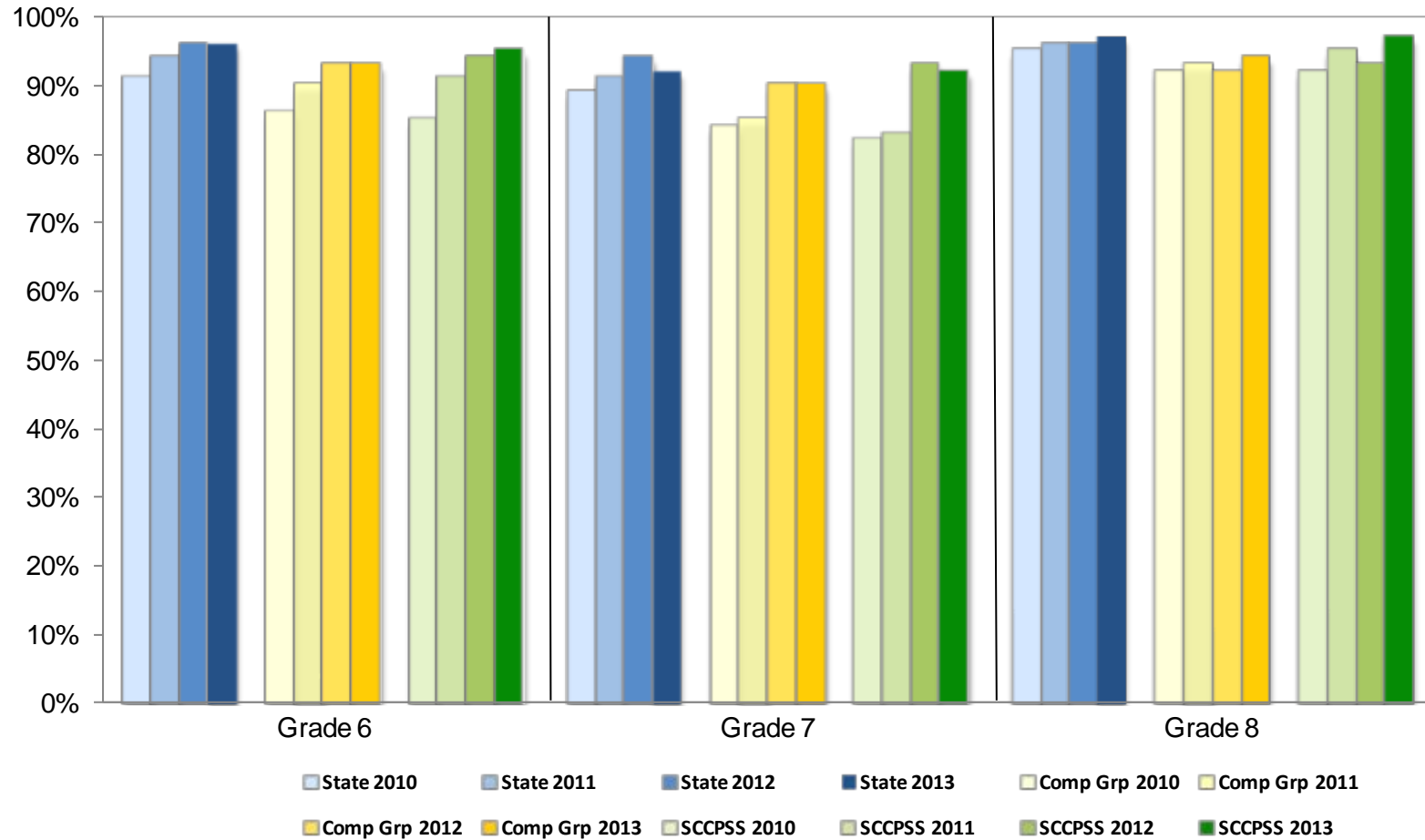

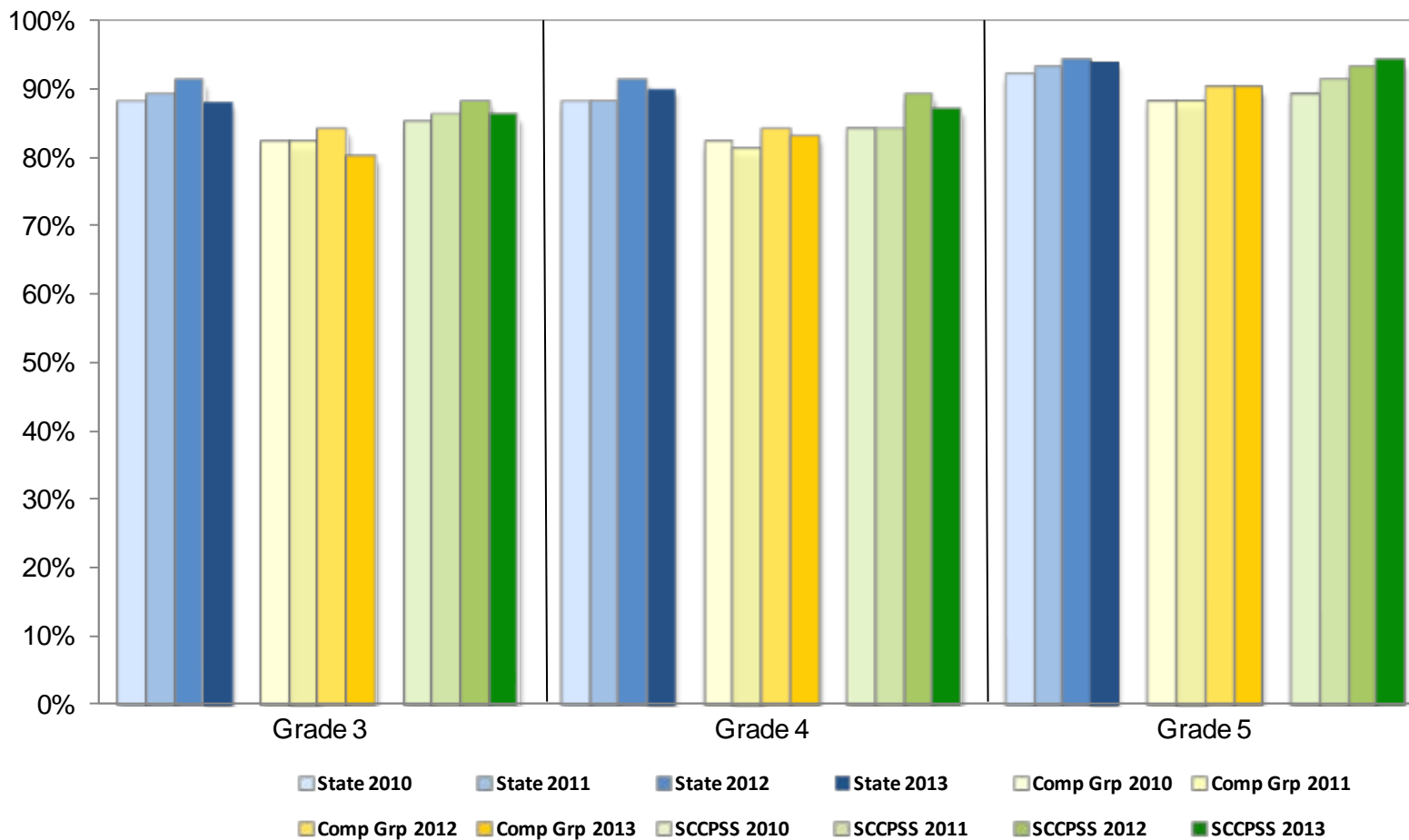

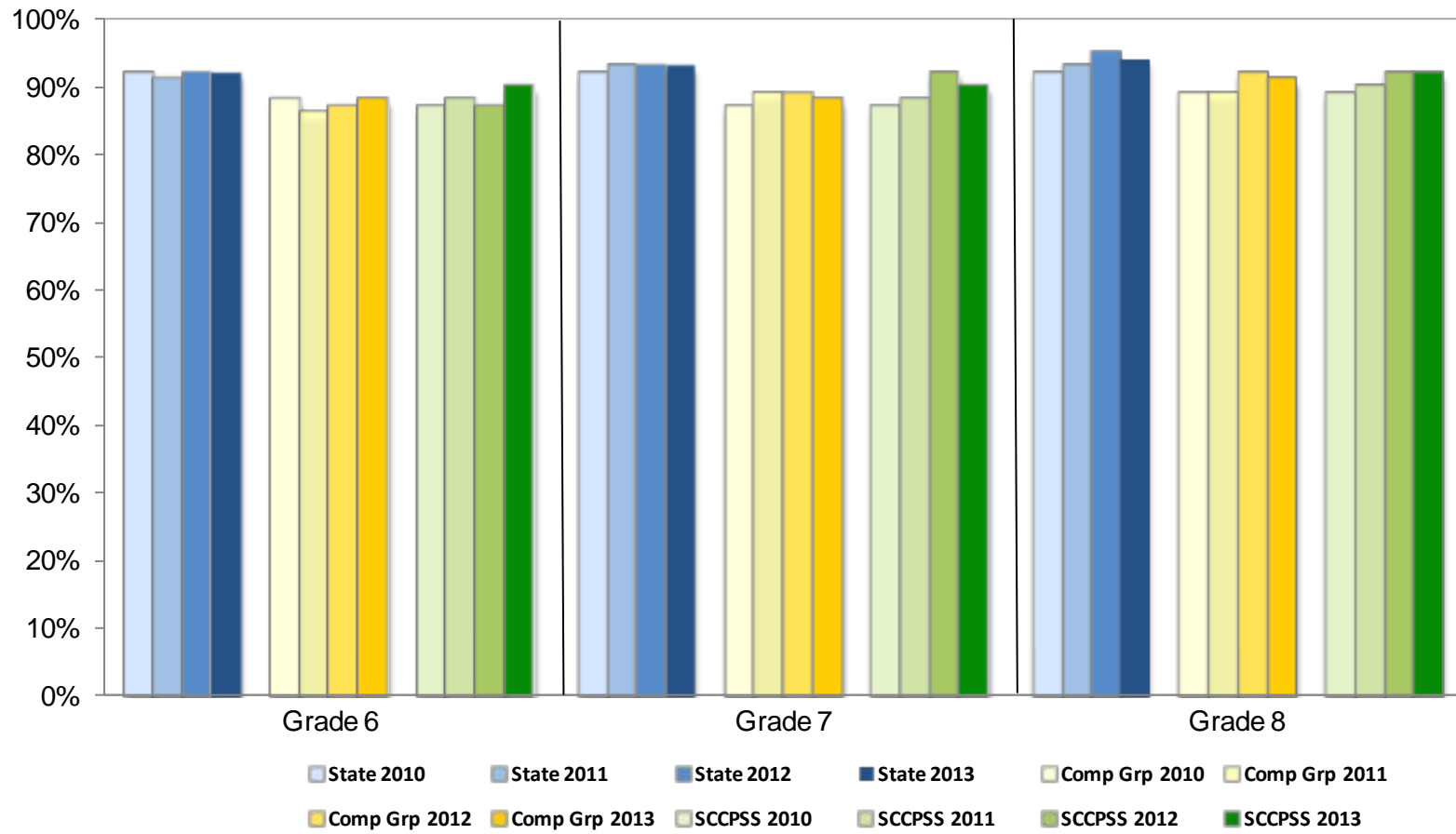

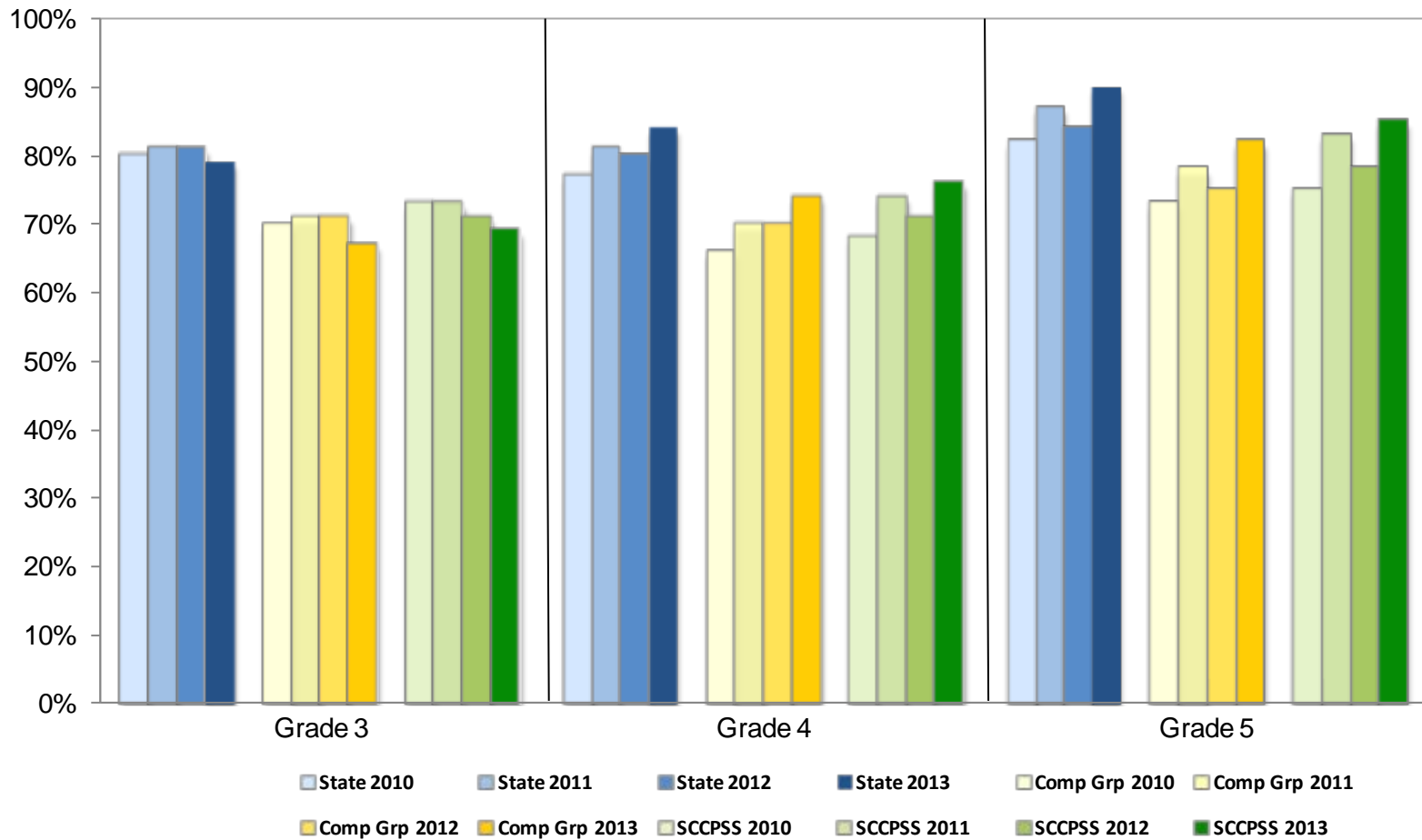

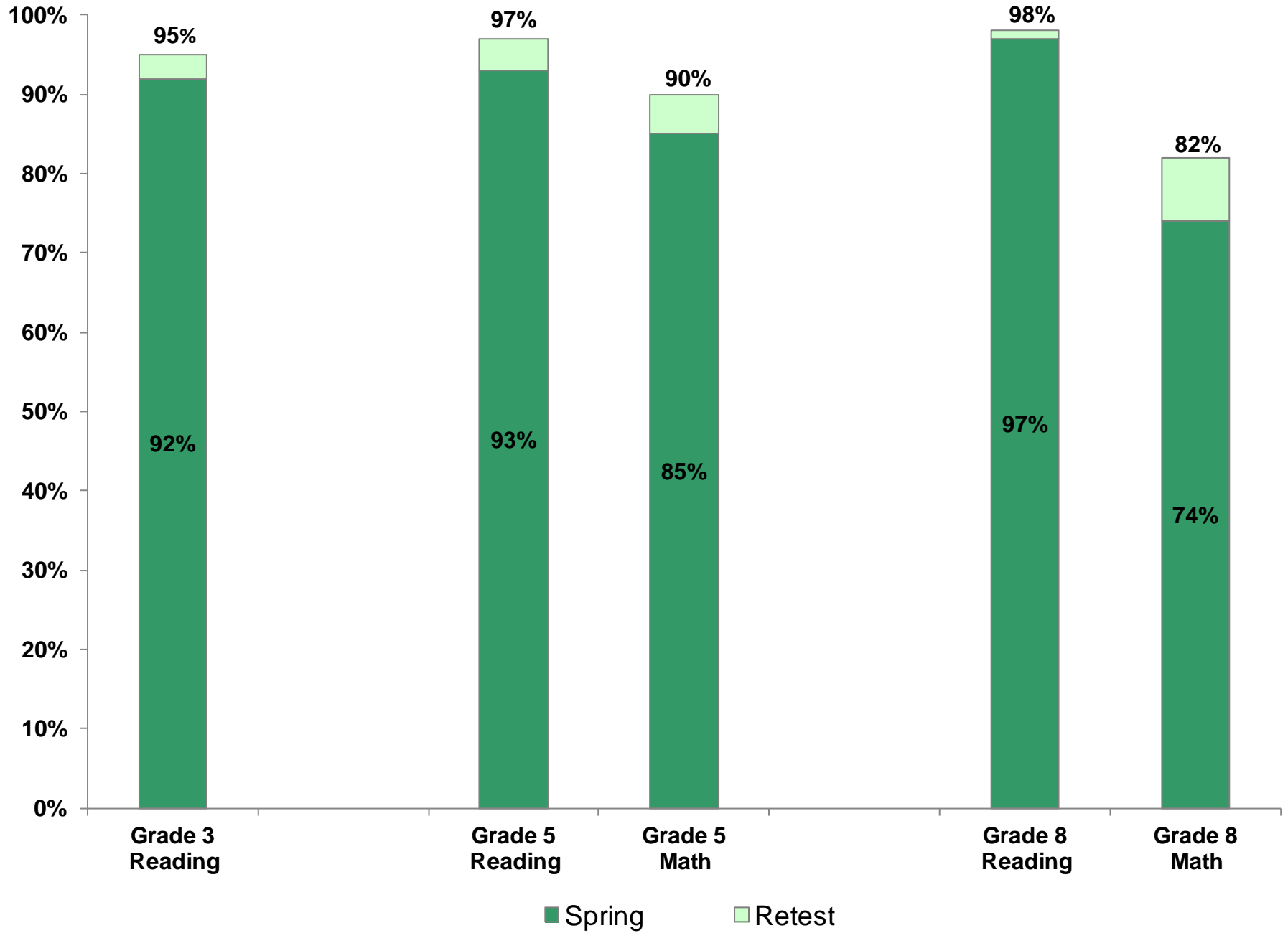

Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard on the CRCT: With 2013 Retest



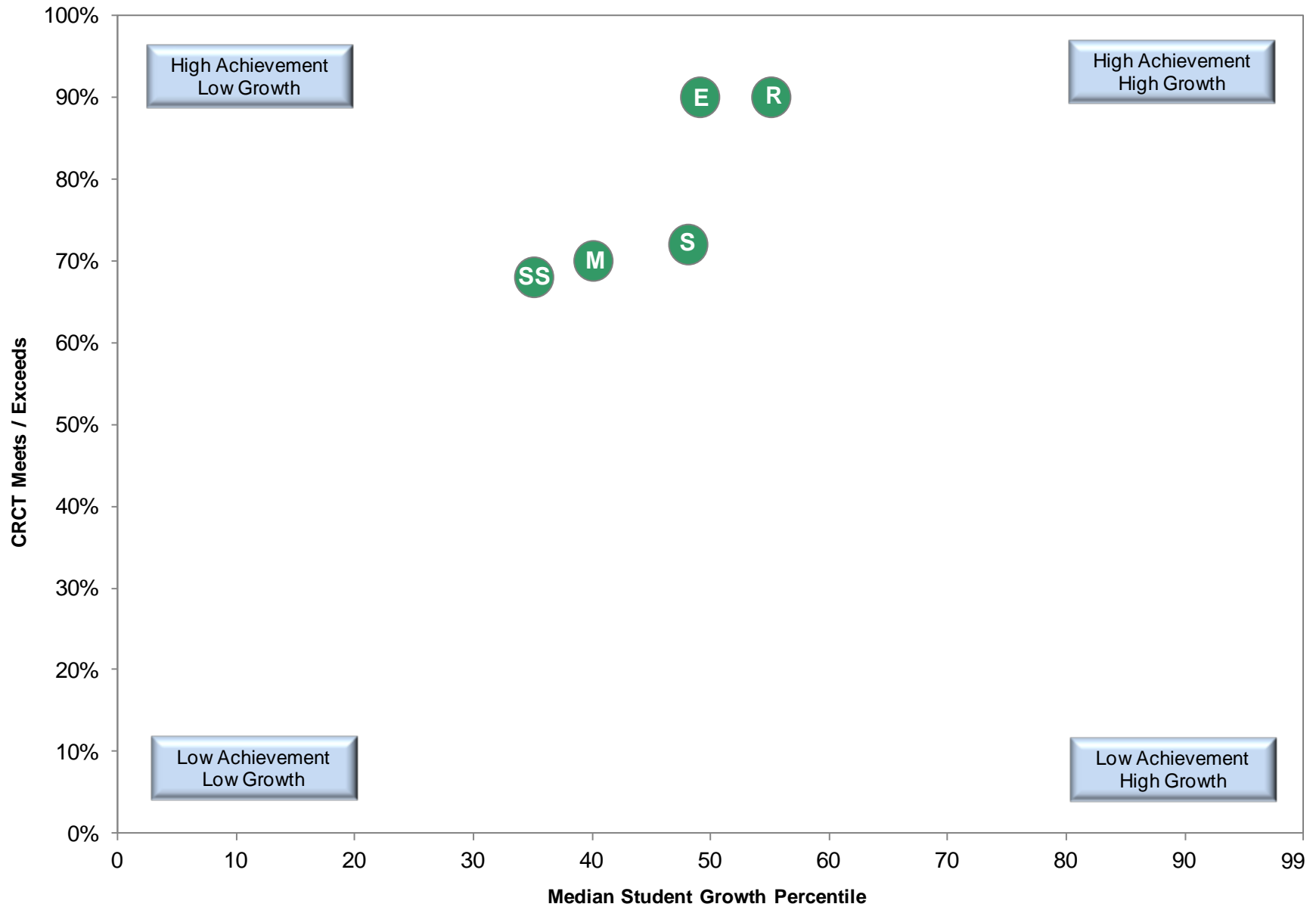

CRCT Achievement and Growth: Student Growth Percentiles 4th Grade 2012

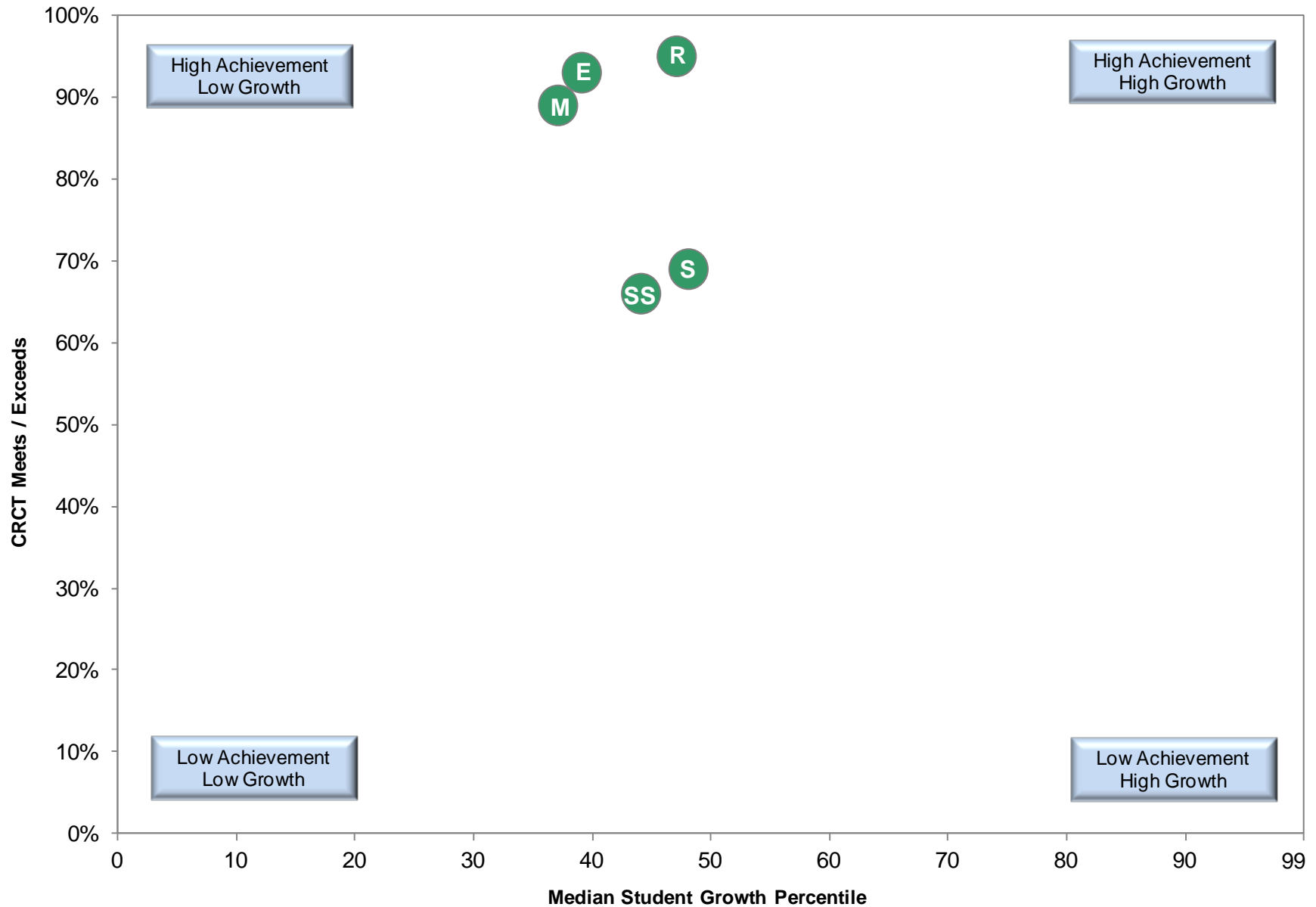

CRCT Achievement and Growth: Student Growth Percentiles 5th Grade 2012

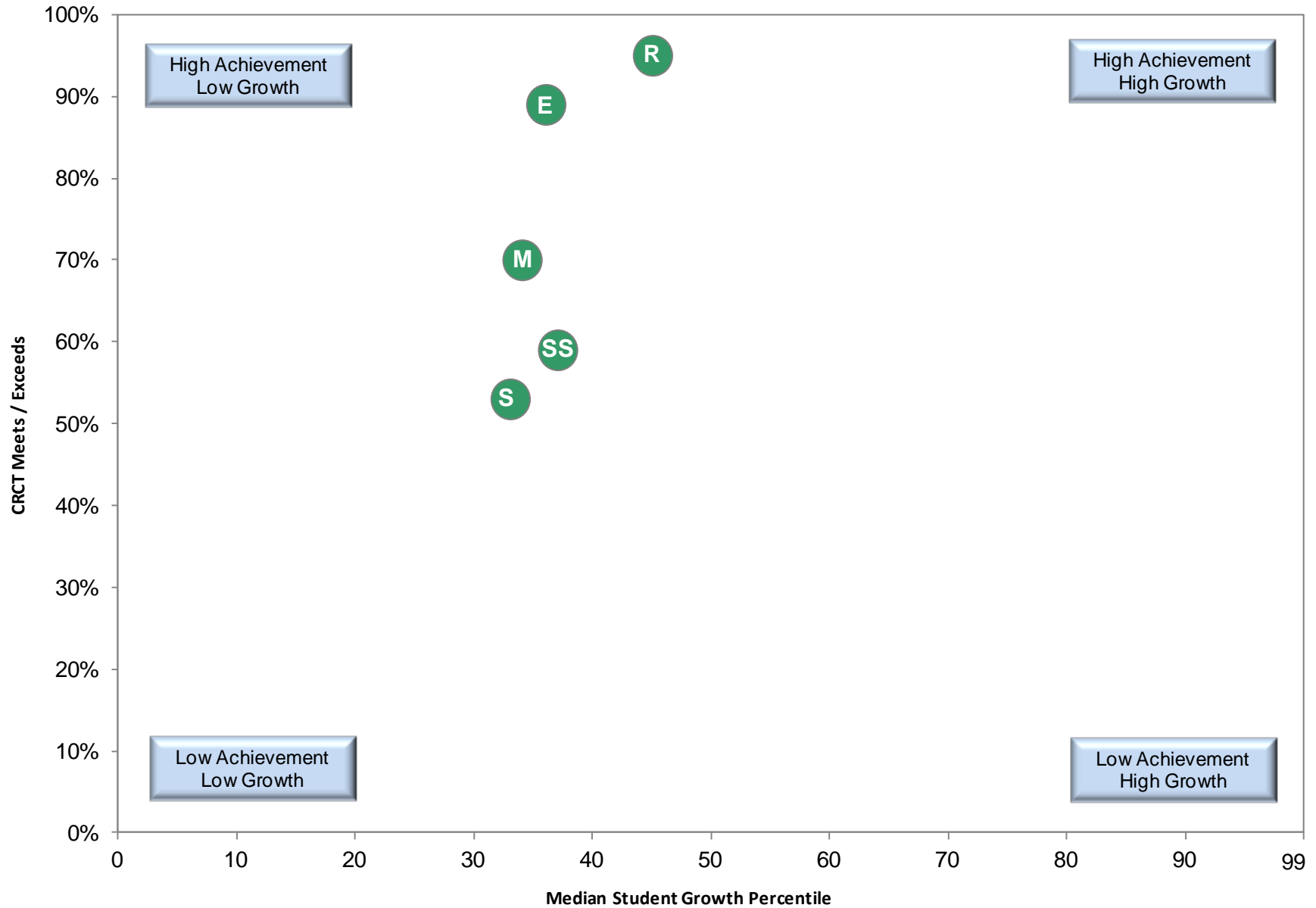

CRCT Achievement and Growth: Student Growth Percentiles 6th Grade 2012

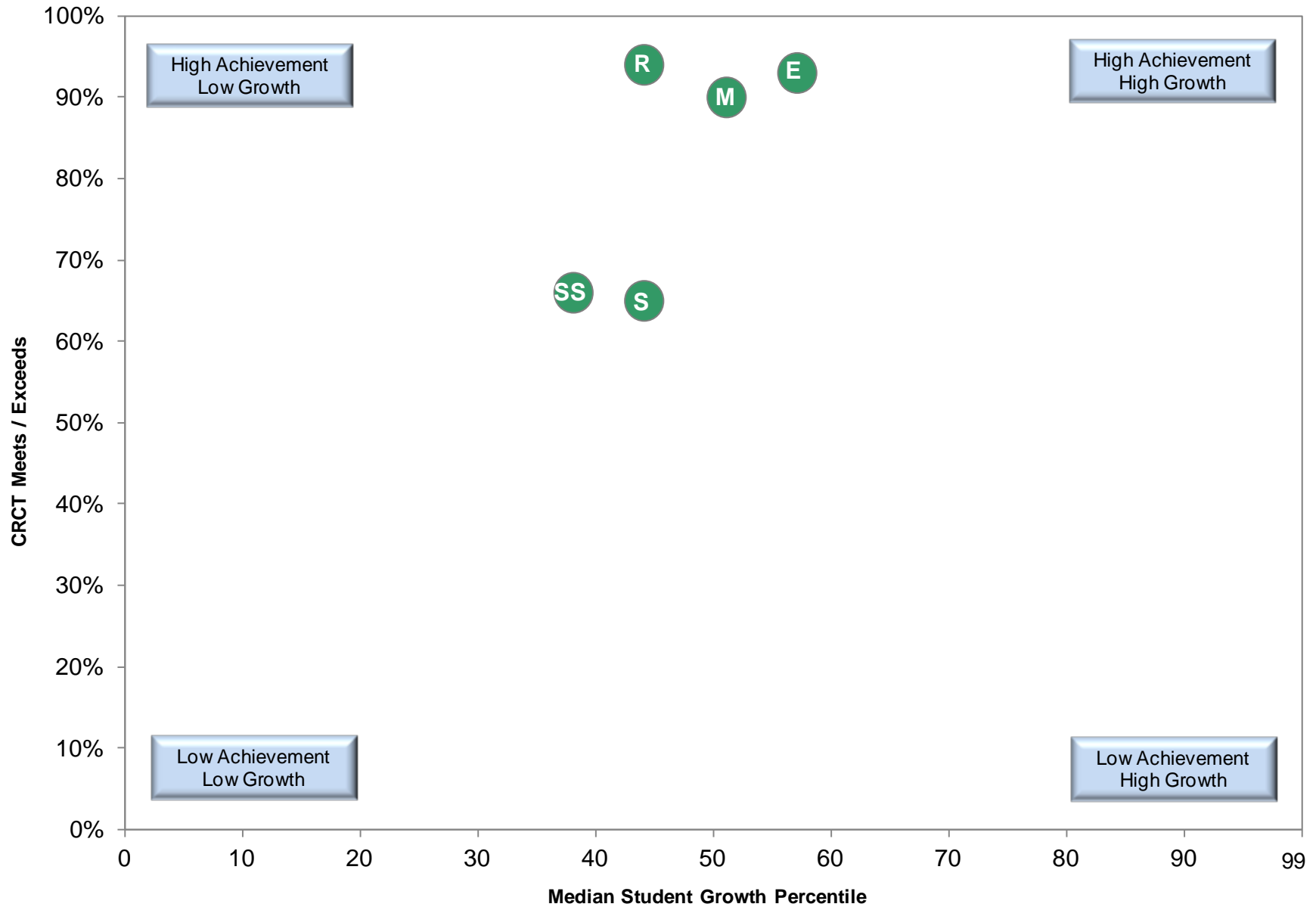

CRCT Achievement and Growth: Student Growth Percentiles 7th Grade 2012

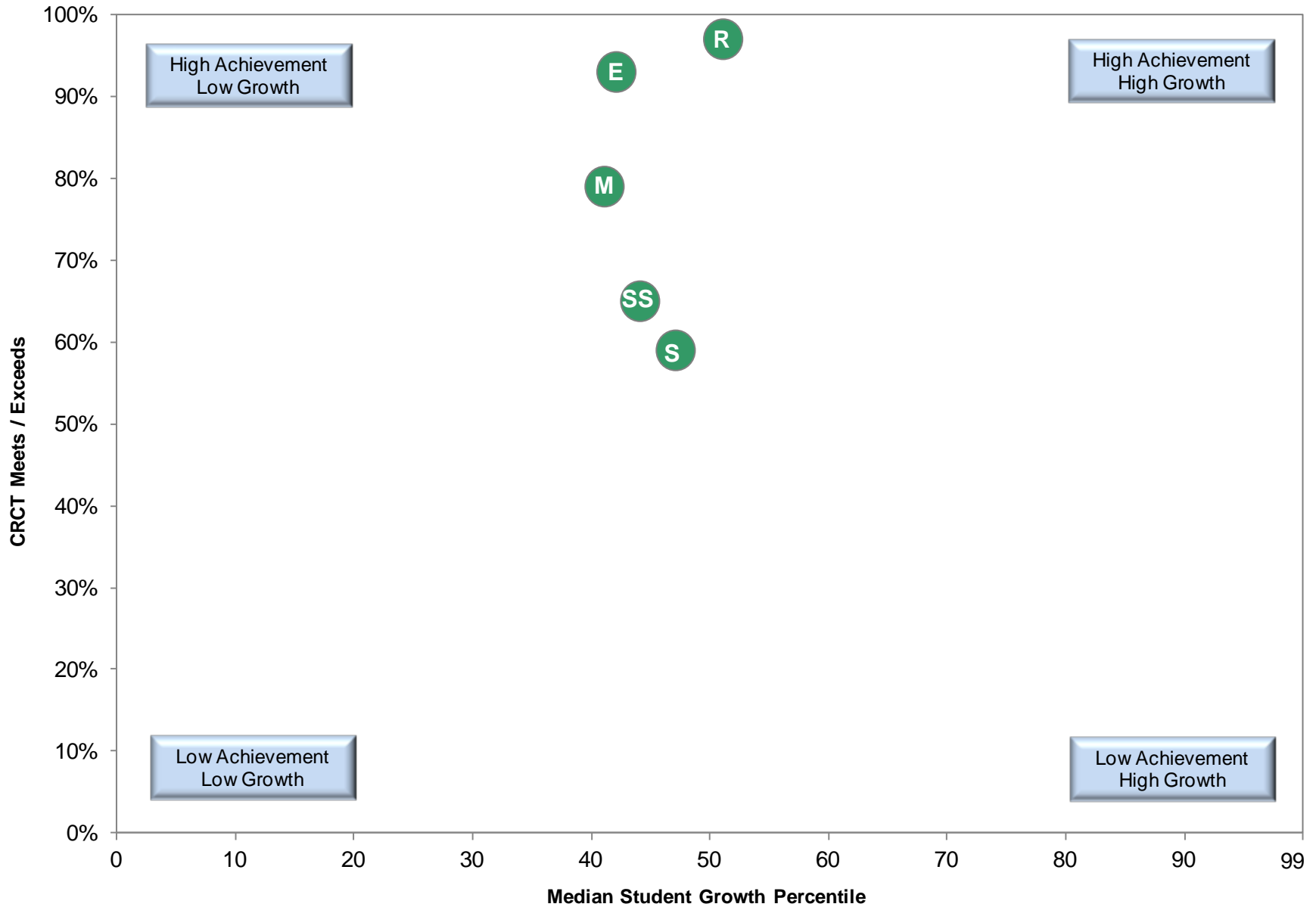
