***Emergency Preparedness***

- **Objective**

- To ensure preparedness of schools in the event of an emergency/crisis situation by conducting live and simulated exercises at all sites

- **Target**

- A. 100% of schools will conduct a minimum of 1 live crisis mitigation exercise per year and a minimum of 2 simulated (table top) exercises per year
- B. The school district will conduct a minimum of 1 centralized crisis mitigation exercise per year and minimum of 2 simulated (table top) exercises per year

## **What we have accomplished:**

### *School Safety Site Surveys:*

- As of August 2013, 100% of all elementary and K-8 schools were completed
- To date, School Safety Site Surveys have been completed at all the high schools, middle schools and charter schools

# Ocularis Camera System

To date, all elementary, K-8, middle and high schools have camera coverage of the entrance of the school and all exits locations of the building.

## **School Exercises**

100% of schools completed two (2) tabletop exercises and one (1) functional (simulated) exercise for the FY 2013-14 school year.

# Central Office Security Measures

In continued efforts to enhance security throughout the building:

- Security cameras have been installed to monitor movement
- The cameras provide coverage for all entrances and exits
- An intercom system has been installed to provide auditory notification for staff and visitors in case of an emergency

# Central Office Security Measures Cont.

## *The Fast Pass Visitor System:*

The system has several enhanced features:

- The person's picture and destination is printed on a self-adhesive badge
- Upon checking in at the front desk, an email with a color picture of the visitor is sent to the destination advising them of the visitor en route to their location



## **What we are doing:**

Plans are in place to revise & updating the green & red emergency response flipcharts to include “active shooter” scenarios.

The district’s Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) template has been updated for distribution to schools for SY 14-15.



## **What we are doing:**

With the New Georgia Firearms Carry Law enacted on July 1, 2014, a metal detector will be located at the entrance of central office and a sworn officer will be posted at the building.

## Lessons Learned:

- Continued training is necessary as administrators move to new sites, current personnel assume new roles in administration, and new staff join the district
- Sites continue good usage of their flip guides

## **Action Items:**

- Provide additional support and practice evacuation for schools having on-site constructions
- Include outside observations for sites with camera systems
