Objective D: Weapons and Drugs

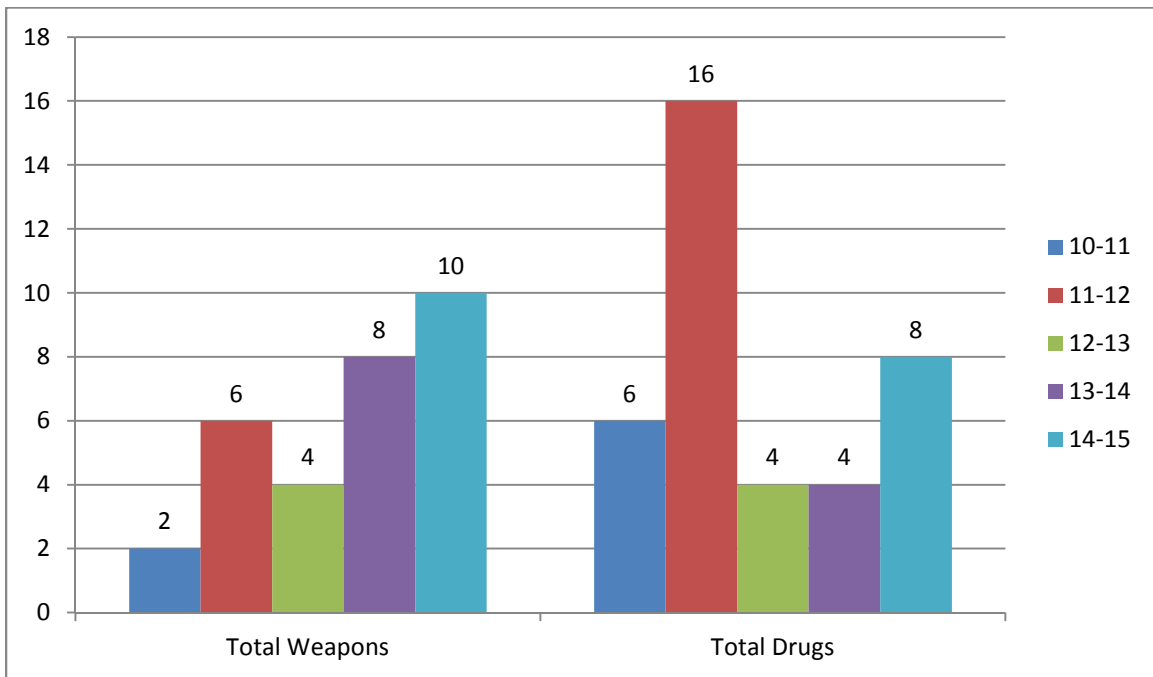
First Quarter Report: 2014-2015 School Year

Executive Summary

In accordance with Strategic Objective 3D, the district is to reduce the number of Weapons and Drugs on school campuses as measured by official police reports to 45 or less in each category by SY 2014-15. There has been a slight increase in both weapons and drug violations as compared to the first quarter of SY 2013-14. For the period of July 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014 there have been 8 incidents involving drug violations and 10 incidents involving weapons violations.

With an emphasis on Strategic Objective 3D, we are ensuring that a minimum of three (3) Random Administrative Inspections are done per school every week. In addition, the schools are varying the locations of the RAI's for more effectiveness. The Random Administrative Inspections and continued Safe School Searches are a part of the normal routine of all schools, thus providing a major deterrent for students looking to bring weapons and/or drugs onto school campuses.

1st Quarter Drugs and Weapons Comparison



Attached is a breakdown of drug and weapons violations by elementary, K-8, middle, high and alternative schools for the period of July 1 through September 30, 2014.

Drug violations are viewed under four areas of the official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

- OCGA 16-13-30 Purchase, possession, manufacture, distribution, or sale of controlled substances or marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (a) Purchase, possess, or have under control any controlled substance.
- OCGA 16-13-30 (j) Possession, have under control, manufacture, deliver, distribute, dispense, administer, purchase, sell, or possess with intent to distribute marijuana.
- OCGA 16-13-32.4 Manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled substances in, on, or near public or private schools

Weapons are viewed under the following official criminal code of the State of Georgia:

- OCGA 16-11-127.1 Carrying weapons within school safety zones, at school functions, or on school property.
