TOPIC	DISCUSSION and Summary*
Opening: Pledge Allegiance/Inspiration	Mrs. Tiffany Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 3:48 PM. Council members recited the pledge of allegiance. Members introduced themselves to the newest council member, Rachel Ridley.
APPROVAL OF MINUTES:	Ms. Curry read aloud the minutes from the last meeting. Ashley Hutchenson made the motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Rachel Ridley. The minutes were approved.
OLD BUSINESS:	Media Specialist – See Principal’s Report
PRINCIPAL’S REPORT:	<p>New Media Specialist - Ms. Curry announced the hiring of Hannah Mayes. Technology is one of her strengths. Ms. Mayes will be able to offer support to the STEAM initiative.</p> <p>School Resource Officer - Officer Walker requested to transfer schools. A new resource officer, Officer Reedy was introduced to the school. Her duties will be to secure the building, build relationships with students, and provide lessons on school safety.</p> <p>CCRPI Review - The overall CCRPI score increased to 69.1. The progress score, which is growth, went up in both ELA and math (71.4). The overall content mastery, which is achievement, went down (69.4). ELA achievement was the only area of improvement. Math achievement saw a small drop but the drop in science and social studies was significant. The readiness score decreases a small amount (84.1). Attendance caused the decrease in this area. Closing the gaps, which indicates progress among subgroups, is the area that showed the most significant decrease (43.2). No subgroup met the target in the area of social studies. Only the white subgroups met the target in the area of science. All subgroups except students with disabilities met the ELA target. The overall score for the school climate survey was 93.9.</p> <p>Initiatives for making progress – Building relationships with students is necessary to motivate them to learn. Many opportunities for student recognition have been initiated (honor roll, perfect attendance, AR goals).</p>
