Uniforms are required for all SCCPSS students

Show Your Warrior Pride! — Be sure your student is properly attired

Top:

- Shirts must be pullover style polo, turtleneck, or collared, Oxford-style button up. NO t-shirts.
- All shirts must be tucked in both males and females must
- Solid colors only Red or White only! The following are not acceptable ... Black, grey, stripes, prints, plaids, etc.
- ornamentation (or logo) is permitted. Tops may have a school approved insignia. No other
- Undergarments must not be visible.
- Solid colored sweaters, vests or sweatshirts may be worn over uniform shirts. Hooded sweatshirts are not permitted.

Bottom:

- Pants, skirts, shorts and skorts must be standard uniform No denim regardless of color material (cotton and/or twill). They must have a finished hem.
- Pants, skirts, shorts and skorts must be solid khaki in color. Females may wear plaid skirts and jumpers (approved plaid
- Skirts, shorts and skorts may not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- Undergarments must not be visible.
- Bottoms must be an appropriate size and must be worn at the any garment having belt loops. natural waist and not drag the floor. Belts must be worn with
- No cargo pockets, zippers, or other embellishments. Jeans, leggings, jogging and cargo pants are not acceptable.

- Hooded sweatshirts, hats and sunglasses ARE NOT permitted.

Shoes & Hosiery:

- Shoes must be completely enclosed (toe, heel, and sides).
- Sandals, flip flops, slides, clogs, Crocs, etc are not acceptable
- Shoes must be fastened or tied properly.
- Socks or tights must be solid in color; acceptable colors are white, tan and black.
- Pantyhose must be natural in color and free of design

Backpacks, Bookbags, Athletic Bags & Purses:
