September-Cooperation Do your share to make your school and community better. Cooperate. Get involved in community affairs. Stay informed; vote. Be a good neighbor. Obey laws and rules. Respect authority. Protect the environment. Volunteer.

October-Responsibility Do what you are supposed to do. Plan ahead. Persevere: keep on trying! Always do your best. Use self-control. Be self-disciplined. Think before you act — consider the consequences. Be accountable for your words, actions, and attitudes. Set a good example for others.

November-Caring Doing good deeds and showing concern for others. Be compassionate and empathetic. Be kind, loving and considerate. Be thankful and express gratitude for what people do for you. Forgive others for their shortcomings. Don't be mean, cruel or insensitive. Give money, time, support and comfort without strings. Do what you can for the sake of making someone's life better-not for praise or gratitude. Help people in need.

December-Peace Prevent and solve conflicts. Communicate effectively. Show compassion for others. Be respectful to others. Handle conflicts in a non-violent way.

January-Compassion Be kind. Be compassionate and show you care. Express gratitude. Forgive others. Help people in need.

February-Fairness Play by the rules. Take turns and share. Be open-minded; listen to others. Don't take advantage of others. Don't blame others carelessly. Treat all people fairly.

March-Trustworthiness Be honest. Don't deceive, cheat, or steal. Be reliable — do what you say you'll do. Have the courage to do the right thing. Build a good reputation. Be loyal — stand by your family, friends, and country.

April-Respect Treat others with respect; follow the Golden Rule. Be tolerant and accepting of differences. Use good manners, not bad language. Be considerate of the feelings of others. Don't threaten, hit or hurt anyone. Deal peacefully with anger, insults, and disagreements.

May-Perseverance Stay with the task and don't give up. Show commitment, pride and a positive attitude in completing tasks. Try again and again and again. Be patient and willing to work hard.
