Tentative Itinerary:

Departure:

6:00 am Depart for Perry, GA
9:30 am Arrive at the Georgia National Fairgrounds
9:30 – 10:00 Registration
10:00-11:00 Motivational General Session
12:30-3:30 FBLA Day at the Georgia National Fair
1:00 -3:00 FBLA Team Open Events Testing

Return:

3:00- 3:30 pm Load van/bus at Fairgrounds and Depart for Savannah
6:00-6:30 pm Arrive at school for pick up

Meal:

- Participants need to have cash to buy food from food vendors at the Fair (min \$12)
- Make sure you have something for breakfast with you. We will only stop in the rest area on I-16 on the way to the Rally. It's ok to bring small snacks and drinks with you. But please do not make a mess and **take care of your trash!**

Dress Code:

- FBLA T-shirt required for all previous members and recommended for all new members. Otherwise – a burgundy polo shirt (school shirt)
- Comfortable pants
 - Jeans or pants (“neat” – **without holes or frays**)
 - Shorts (no more than two inches above the knee)
- Sneakers or other comfortable shoes (no sandals for safety reasons)

- **Inappropriate attire!!!:**
 - Shirts with inappropriate graphics, logos, or themes
 - Denim or jeans with holes, significant frays, etc. Neat jeans are acceptable.
 - Backless, see-through, tight-fitting, spaghetti straps, strapless, *extremely short* or low-cut blouses, tops, dresses, or shorts.
 - Lycra, spandex, midriff tops, tank tops, athletic wear.
 - Hats or flannel fabric clothing.
 - Visible foundation garments.
 - Clothing with inappropriate slogans
 - Accessories which are inappropriate for a business casual environment. This includes but is not limited to excessive chains and jewelry, exposed body piercing, and other items.

Code of Conduct:

It is the responsibility of all delegates to conduct themselves in a proper, businesslike manner at all times.

1. All delegates shall behave in a courteous and respectful manner and refrain from language and/or actions that could bring discredit upon them, their school, and/or FBLA.
2. Conduct not conducive to an educational conference will not be tolerated. Examples of unacceptable conduct include, but are not limited to, talking during the session, disrupting a businesslike atmosphere, consorting with non-conference individuals or any activities which endanger self or others.
3. Delegates shall keep their advisers informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times. Accidents, injuries, or illnesses must be reported to the local or state adviser immediately.
4. Delegates must follow the proscribed dress code for the Rally. Delegates not in adherence to the dress code will not be allowed to participate. Advisers are responsible for enforcing their students' dress code and conduct.
5. No alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, or drugs may be possessed at anytime, under any circumstances. Use or possession of such substances may subject the delegate to criminal prosecution.
6. Conference delegates are guests of the Georgia National Fairgrounds and must not deface or destroy property. Any damages to property or furnishings in the arena or fair will be paid for by the individual or chapter responsible.
