Membership & Eligibility:

- ◆ Students must have a 90+ GPA with a majority of honors/accelerated/AP/IB classes, be academically successful in the current semester, and have a clean discipline record to be invited to apply to NHS
- ◆ In October, eligible students in 10th, 11th, and 12th grade will be invited to complete an application packet
- ◆ Completed packets will be reviewed by a faculty committee
- ◆ Successful applicants and their families will be invited to attend an Induction Ceremony toward the end of the fall semester
- ◆ Once inducted, members are expected to be active participants in club activities and meetings

Club Activities:

- ◆ Members attend meetings held after school on the last Wednesday of the month
- ◆ Members participate in community service projects throughout the year. Recent community service projects have benefitted:
 - Tybee Island Beach Sweep
 - Savannah Children's Heart Center (donation of toys and decorations)
 - Girls on the Run
 - Relay for Life (American Cancer Society)
 - Operation Gratitude (military care packages)
 - Emmaus House (toiletry drive for local homeless shelter)
 - Holiday coloring books for children's hospital/Greenbrier
